About us:

The MSC is a bowling venue for fifty and older players, female or male. Please note that all participants must be at LEAST 50 years of age on the day of the tournament to compete.

Dues & Fees:

The MSC offers 12 Events per year, June through May. Entry Fees for each tournament are \$90 for Members and \$100 for Non-Members. The MSC Membership is \$45 per participant each season. Non-member fees are not applicable to the membership fee. Cash is the preferred method of entry fees. For first time entrants, checks will be accepted.

How it Works:

Payout is 1 for 2, same day. The format is 7 random match games, with an 8th game being a position round. The top 5 plus any seeds go into the stepladder. A 4 or 5 game Stepladder follows. When there are 4 or more Super Seniors or if there are 4 or More Real Old Guys, one must be in the ladder. There must be at least one bowler over 59 years of age in the ladder.

To cash, one must finish in the top 50% of one's age bracket, otherwise you **DO NOT** cash. Cashing will be based on 1 for 2 for each age bracket. Only exceptions: all players over 59 who finish in the natural prize list will cash.

Women are guaranteed a 1 for 2 pay out

The year-end tournament has added money to each payout position. To qualify for the year end event, a bowler must be a member and have played at **least 4** tournaments in the 2018-2019 season.

Any questions regarding payout and scoring will be left to the discretion of the Director.

Age Classifications:

50 through 59 is a "Regular"

60 through 67 is a "Super Senior" (SS)
68 and Older is a "Real Old Guy" (ROG).
One's age determines the bracket they are in.

Every tournament is certified by the USBC.

Rob Downer, from game 1 to the final, had it going for his 3rd win of the season. The win ties him with Clark Poelzer for most career titles with 20. The win moves him into the top 5 of the PoY points list, despite missing 2 tournaments. The condition was to his liking as he averaged 243 for qualifying. The title match was not easy as the match was decided in the 10th frame. His opponent, Sam Lantto, had an opportunity to tie the match, but it was not to be. Instead of winning his 4th title, he finished 2nd. To get to the final, he defeated Craig Schiffler in a close match, also decided in the 10th.

Schiffler is looking to win his 6th title. To get to the semifinal, he defeated Tom Corbett and Dave Oulman. The match against Lantto was decided in the 10th when, needing a double, left a 9 pin on the 2nd shot after striking in the 11th. He was 2nd high scratch qualifier. He had the 1st 8 against Oulman.

Oulman was 3rd high qualifier and is looking for title #3. Oulman had a 300 during qualifying. There is no defense against the 1st 8, but still bowled a nice 218. The 4th place finish gave him enough points to assume the leadership of the PoY list.

Fifth place was taken by Tom Corbett. He defeated Carl Hendrickson in the first ladder game to meet Schiffler. Against Schiffler, he had 3 splits which determined the out come of the game. He did strike out in the 10th. Schiffler shot 237 to win. Corbett is a part time MSC player and has 2 seconds and 3 thirds to his credit.

The 6th player in the ladder was Carl Hendrickson, seeded as the high RoG. He couldn't get anything going as he lost to Corbett. He has 2 titles and 3 seconds to his credit.
