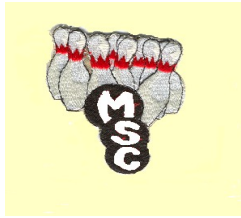


MIDWEST SENIOR CLASSIC

The MSC is a bowling venue for fifty and older players (male or female) to compete in against each other.

You must be at least 50 on the day of the tournament.

We have 12 events per year, June through May.

Entry fee is \$90 for members, \$100 for non-members, membership is \$45 per season.

Payout is 1 for 2, same day.

Format is 8 match gms, with the 8th game being a position round. This is followed by a stepladder.

If any age bracket has 8 or more, then that group is guaranteed a spot in the ladder. If no group has 8 or more, then at least 1 player over 59 must be in the ladder.

Age Classifications

50 through 58 is a regular

59 through 64 is a super senior(ss)

65 through 69 is a super duper(sds)

70 and older is a real old guy(rog)

Payout is guaranteed 1 for 2 for ss, sds and rogs.

The year end tournament has added money to each payout position.

To qualify for the year end event, you must be a member and have played at least 4 tournaments in the 2011-2012 season.

For every 13 bowlers, there will be a non casher high game

Your age determines your classification. You do not have the option of moving into another age bracket.

Any questions related to payout and scoring will be left to the discretion of the Director.

Each MSC tournament is certified by the USBC

Brian Floen won for the third consecutive month. He now has 6 titles. The title was his 4th of the season. This ties the mark of Al Loth and Clark Poelzer, each of whom had 4 win seasons. Brian qualified first and out averaged his nearest competitor by 10 pins a game. He also has had at least 24 consecutive 200 games. Three titles in a row has been accomplished once before by Al Loth.

Floen and Downer were even through 5 frames in the title game. Downer had a split open in the 5th that tilted the game towards Floen. Brian stayed clean to win.

Downer had another good tournament. He is looking for his 3rd title of the season and 5th of his MSC career. He also kept his streak of never failing to cash in a MSC tournament. That streak is now up to 20. Downer was 3rd high qualifier. To get to the title game, he had to get pass 2 tough opponents in the person of Ron Stepp and Ken Holets.

Ken Holets finished third. He qualified in second and ran into a red hot Downer. A stubborn 10 pin cost him the chance to advance. With this finish, he moves into the top 10 in the point standings. Ken is looking for title #3, to go along with 5 seconds.

Fourth place went to Super Duper Senior Ron Stepp. Ron qualified in 7th and shot 260 and a 205 to win 2 ladder games. He then shot a 256 and lost a close game to Downer. Ron has several top 5 finishes to his credit.

Finishing in 5th was Bob Micek. This was his 2nd consecutive top 5 finish. Look for this youngster to win a title soon.

In 6th was another youngster, Dave Freeman, playing his first MSC. This guy is going to win a title eventually.

The last stepladder player was Terry Schacht, a 5 time titlist.
