About us:

The MSC is a bowling venue for fifty and older players, female or male. Please note that all participants must be at LEAST 50 years of age on the day of the tournament to compete.

Dues & Fees:

The MSC offers 12 Events per year, June through May. Entry Fees for each tournament are \$90 for Members and \$100 for Non-Members. The MSC Membership is \$45 per participant each season. Non-member fees are not applicable to the membership fee.

How it Works:

Payout is 1 for 2, same day. The format is 7 random match games, with an 8th game being a position round. A 4 or 5 game Step Ladder follows. When there are 4 or more Super Seniors or if there are 4 or More Real Old Guys, one must be in the ladder. There must be at least one bowler over 59 years of age in the ladder.

To cash, one must finish in the top 50% of one's age bracket, otherwise you **DO NOT** cash. Cashing will be based on 1 for 2 for each age bracket. Only exception is: all players over 59 who finish in the natural prize list will cash.

The year-end tournament has added money to each payout position. To qualify for the year end event, a bowler must be a member and have played at **least 4** tournaments in the 2017-2018 season.

Any questions regarding payout and scoring will be left to the discretion of the Director.

Age Classifications:

50 through 59 is a "Regular"
60 through 67 is a "Super Senior" (SS)
68 and Older is a "Real Old Guy" (ROG).
One's age determines the bracket they are in.

Each tournament is certified by the USBC.

MSC, LOOK OUT!!, Brian Floen has recovered from his surgery. Witness a 2058 qualifying total, 8 match wins, and shooting a 257 against challenger Dave Oulman to win his 11th title. Floen had 4 games over 260, including 2 "300's". Floen started with a double and did not stop.

Oulman qualified 5th, defeated 4 opponents to get to the title game. Oulman eked by Daybow Adams and Tom Jones before easing past Dave Olynyk and Sam Lantto. Oulman is looking for title number 2, but settled for his 5th second. For the 13 games, he averaged 233. Another good event for him.

Third place went to Lantto, the 2nd such finish in MSC tournaments. Lantto qualified second. He is looking for title #3. He did not have enough strikes to defeat a red hot Oulman. But, another good tournament for him.

With his highest finish to date, a 4th place, was Olynyk. Olynyk was 3rd high qualifier. He had a 299 during qualifying while averaging 242. A couple of back row pins cost him in the match against Oulman. Nevertheless, a very good event for him.

Tom Jones, bowling only his 3rd or 4th MSC, finished 5th. Jones had 3 splits against Oulman, and he nearly overcome them, only to lose by 1 pin. A backrow pin in the 10th was the game decider. Jones was the 4th high qualifier, overcoming a 186 start.

Playing the 1st ladder game were the 2 seeds, Daybow Adams and Ken Holets. Adams won the game and the right to meet the 5th seeded player. AS noted, he lost a close game to Oulman, 234 to 237.
