You must be at least 50 on the day of the tournament.

We have 12 events per year, June through May. Entry fee is \$90 for members, \$100 for non- members, membership is \$45 per season.

Payout is 1 for 2, same day.
The format is 8 random match
games, with the 8 game being a
position round. A 4,5 or 6 game
step ladder follows

When there are 8 or more SS or, if there are 6 or more SDS, one must be in the ladder; and if there are 4 or more ROGs, one must be in the ladder.

There must be at least one player under 59 and at least one player over 59 in the ladder, no matter anything else.

Age Classifications
50 through 58 is a regular
59 through 64 is a super senior(ss)
65 through 69 is a super duper(sds)
70 and older is a real old guy(rog)

To cash, you must finish in the top 50% Of your age bracket. Payout is guaranteed

The year end tournament has added money to each payout position. To qualify for the year end event, you must be a member and have played at least 4 tournaments in the 2013-14 season.

Brian Floen is "back". The lefty increased his MSC title total to 7 by defeating the defending "PoY" Rob Downer, 226 to 213 in the title match. Floen was the leading qualifier. His scratch total of 2026 is a season high. He had an 802 in games 4, 5 & 6, which included a 299.

For Downer, another top 5 finish. He is looking for title #9. His scratch total of 1989 was the 2nd high season scratch total. With this finish, he increased his "PoY" total to 90. He beat Terry Halida 279 to 258 in the semi final to advance.

Terry is looking for title #3. Terry was 3rd high qualifier and defeated Steve Sherman to advance.

Sherman had his best finish to date. He won 2 ladder games before he met Halida. He emerged as the winner in the 1st ladder game and won a 9th and 10th frame roll off against Tim Racette.

Racette, a 3 time titlist, was 4th high qualifier and finishes in 5th. With this finish, he moves into 6th in the "PoY" race. With 6 events remaining, he can be a factor in the points race.

The other 2 ladder participants were Tom Korth and George Blazej. Both players were the victims of Sherman's 267 game. Tom was a strike short of winning the match, as he had 258. Tom is looking for title #9.

George has never won, but has been tough to beat. He has several top 5 finishes. He had a "300" in qualifying.
