# MIDWEST SENIOR CLASSIC

## About us:

The MSC is a bowling venue for fifty and older players, female or male. Please note that all participants must be at LEAST 50 years of age on the day of the tournament to compete.

## Dues \& Fees:

The MSC offers 12 Events per year, June through May. Entry Fees for each tournament are $\$ 90$ for Members and $\$ 100$ for NonMembers. The MSC Membership is $\$ 45$ per participant each season. Non-member fees are not applicable to the membership fee. Cash is the preferred method of entry fees.

For first time entrants, checks will be accepted.

## How it Works:

Payout is 1 for 2 , same day. The format is 7 random match games, with an $8^{\text {th }}$ game being a position round. The top 5 plus any seeds go into the stepladder. A 4 or 5 game Stepladder follows. When there are 4 or more Super Seniors or if there are 4 or More Real Old Guys, one must be in the ladder. There must be at least one bowler over 59 years of age in the ladder.

To cash, one must finish in the top $50 \%$ of one's age bracket, otherwise you DO NOT cash. Cashing will be based on 1 for 2 for each age bracket. Only exceptions: all players over 59 who finish in the natural prize list will cash.
Woman are guaranteed a 1 for 2 pay out
The year-end tournament has added money to each payout position. To qualify for the year end event, a bowler must be a member and have played at least 4 tournaments in the 2017-2018 season.
Any questions regarding payout and scoring will be left to the discretion of the Director.

## Age Classifications:

50 through 59 is a "Regular" 60 through 67 is a "Super Senior" (SS) 68 and Older is a "Real Old Guy" (ROG). One's age determines the bracket they are in.

Every tournament is certified by the USBC.

Craig Goodwin, bowling his first MSC, defeated tournament leader, Dana Wright, to win. To get to the title match, he defeated 11 time titlist Brian Floen in the semifinal game. He began the title match with a turkey. He also had 5 strikes in the final 6 frames to win going away. Goodwin qualified in $2^{\text {nd }}$, as he knocked over 1811 pins and won 8 matches.

Dana Wright qualified $1^{\text {st }}$ with 1937 and 8 wins. Wright was attempting a rare feat, winning consecutive tournaments. He won his first MSC last month. Against Goodwin, he was unable to get consecutives until the $6^{\text {th }}$ frame. By then, he was down 32 pins, a deficit he couldn't overcome.

Brian Floen finished in $3^{\text {rd }}$ for the $7^{\text {th }}$ time to go along with 11 titles. Floen qualified in $3^{\text {rd }}$, met and beat Ken Holets, 235 to 216 to advance. Floen had 4 doubles In the match. Floen gave Holets an opening in the $9^{\text {th }}$ when he missed a 7 pin. He is looking to add a second title this season, having won in July. With this finish he moves into $4^{\text {th }}$ place in the PoY race.

Ken Holets, two time titlist, finished in $4^{\text {th }}$. This was his first top 5 finish since a $3^{\text {rd }}$ place in February, 2014. Holets qualified in sixth, was seeded as the high SS. He defeated 2 opponents to get to the quarter final game. In these 2 games, he shot 244 and 245 . In the game against Floen, he could have advanced had he struck out in the $10^{\text {th }}$. As a result of the position round he moved from $11^{\text {th }}$ place to $6^{\text {th }}$. Look for this guy to finish in the top 5 more often this season.

Larry Hill, bowling his $1^{\text {st }}$ MSC in 4 years, finished fifth. After 6 games, Hill was the leading qualifier. He is now bowling as an RoG. He qualified in $4^{\text {th }}$. Among his 6 top five finishes is a MSC title. Hill met Ken Holets in the second ladder game. In the $1^{\text {st }} 9$ frames, Holets had 7 strikes to win easily. Hill's carry was nonexistent as he had a 190.

48 players participated in this event. The past 3 Andover events had 48, 40 and 48 players. The 48 entrants was the most since the yearend of 2016.
