The MSC is a bowling venue for fifty and older players (male or female) to compete in against each other.

You must be at least 50 on the day of the tournament.

We have 12 events per year, June through May. Entry fee is \$90 for members, \$100 for non-members, membership is \$45 per season.

Payout is 1 for 2, same day.
The format is 8 random match games, with the 8th game being a position round. A 4 or 5 game step ladder follows

When there are 8 or more SS or, if there are 6 or more SDS, one must be in the ladder; and if there are 4 or more ROGs, one must be in the ladder.

There must be at least one player under 59 and at least one player over 59 in the ladder, no matter anything else.

Age Classifications 50 through 58 is a regular 59 through 64 is a super senior(ss) 65 through 69 is a super duper(sds) 70 and older is a real old guy(rog)

To cash, you must finish in the top 50% Of your age bracket. Payout is guaranteed

The year end tournament has added money to each payout position. To qualify for the year end event, you must be a member and have played at least 3 tournaments in the 2014-15 season.

Your age determines your classification. You do not have the option of moving into another age bracket. For more info, go to

Any questions related to payout and scoring will be left to the discretion of the Director.

Chuck Vashaw had a pretty good day as he won this tournament in his MSC debut. He started with a 256 and didn't stop. He coasted through the final, making one good shot after another, as he defeated Dale Seath 279 to 245. He averaged 255 in qualifying and almost 260 for the 9 games he bowled during the day. Oh yeah, he had 805 for his last 3 games, a legal honor count. Hopefully, he will play more MSCs.

As an aside, the past 3 month title games have seen the winner shoot 279.

Dale Seath is looking for title #2. While he did not win, he bowled very well. He defeated 5 opponents on his way to the title game, averaging 240. Dale was seeded into the ladder and almost became the first seed to win.

In 3rd place was 9 time titlist, Brian Floen. A rare errant shot in the 10th frame of the semifinal game was very costly as it prevented him from moving to the title game. He averaged 250 during qualifying. While he did not get his 10th title, the 3rd place finish moved him into 2nd on the PoY list, 1 point behind Downer.

Fourth place went to Kurt Hanke, his high finish to date in his rookie season. A 10 pin leave early in the game became a factor in his loss. While Seath began with a 5 bagger, he began with a strike, the unlucky 10 pin and then a turkey. He was not able to make up the 20 pin difference as he had a clean game. Nevertheless, a very good tournament. Expect this player to win in the future.

Fifth went to Mike Wirz. Mike qualified in 4th, but was 3rd high in scratch pin total. Mike was not very lucky in the match against Seath as he had 5 single pin leaves while Seath had an 8 bagger. With this finish, he moves into PoY contention. Mike is looking for title #6.

Sixth place was taken by Tom Gallivan. Tom is looking for title #3. He also has 7 seconds. Tom earned his spot in the ladder by qualifying in 5th.
Unfortunately, he bowled well, but could not match Seath's string of strikes.

The other player seeded into the ladder was Don Theis. He started well, but it's what one has at the end that matters. He had a pretty good tournament.

- 4: Players bumped from the prize list will be awarded player of the year points.
- 5: A 75 and older age bracket will be created. This bracket will pay 1 for 2. For ladder seeding purposes, this bracket will fall into the 70 to
