You must be at least 50 on the day of the tournament.

We have 12 events per year, June through May. Entry fee is \$90 for members, \$100 for non- members, membership is \$45 per season.

Payout is 1 for 2, same day.
The format is 8 random match
games, with the 8 game being a
position round. A 4,5 or 6 game
step ladder follows

When there are 8 or more SS or, if there are 6 or more SDS, one must be in the ladder; and if there are 4 or more ROGs, one must be in the ladder.

There must be at least one player under 59 and at least one player over 59 in the ladder, no matter anything else.

Age Classifications
50 through 58 is a regular
59 through 64 is a super senior(ss)
65 through 69 is a super duper(sds)
70 and older is a real old guy(rog)

To cash, you must finish in the top 50% Of your age bracket. Payout is guaranteed

The year end tournament has added money to each payout position. To qualify for the year end event, you must be a member and have played at least 4 tournaments in the 2013-14 season.

For every 20 bowlers, there will be a

Your age determines your classification. You do not have the option of moving into another age bracket. For more info, go to midwestseniorclassic.com/

Randy Bartz was the unlucky foe. Randy was 2nd high qualifier. To get to the final, he defeated Dale Seath in the semi final game, 257 to 214. In the final, he wasn't able to get lined up. He is looking for his third title.

Dale qualified in third. He beat Dave Lutz to advance. He was a few strikes short against Bartz. He was one of four players to have 8 200 plus games. He is looking for his second title. Dale has 10 top 5 finishes to his credit.

Fourth went to Dave Lutz. Lutz emerged the victor in the first two ladder games, defeating 2 players who finished qualifying higher than he did. As is the usual case, Lutz was a few back row pins short against Seath.Lutz has 2 titles to his credit.

Tom Gallivan finished in 5th. He qualified in 4th. He lost to Lutz in the second ladder game. Tom has 2 titles and 7 seconds to his credit.

Part time player Bob Miller finished in 6th.
Bob qualified fifth and lost a close game to Lutz in the first ladder game. Bob has a high finish of third.
