## MIDWEST SENIOR CLASSIC



The MSC is a bowling venue for fifty and older players (male or female) to compete in against each other. You must be at least 50 on the day of the tournament.
We have 12 events per year, June through May.
Entry fee is $\$ 90$ for members, $\$ 100$ for non-members, membership is $\$ 45$ per season.
Payout is 1 for 2 , same day. Format is 8 match gms, with the $8^{\text {th }}$ game being a position round. This is followed by a stepladder.
If any age bracket has 8 or more, then that group is guaranteed a spot in the ladder. If no group has 8 or more, then at least 1 player over 59 must be in the ladder.

Age Classifications
50 through 58 is a regular
59 through 64 is a super senior(ss)
65 through 69 is a super duper(sds)
70 and older is a real old guy(rog)
Payout is guaranteed 1 for 2 for ss, sds and rogs.

The year end tournament has added money to each payout position.
To qualify for the year end event, you must be a member and have played at least 4 tournaments in the 2011-2012 season.

For every 13 bowlers, there will be a non casher high game
Your age determines your classification. You do not have the option of moving into another age bracket.

Any questions related to payout and scoring will be left to the discretion of the Director.
Each MSC tournament is certified by the USBC

Tom Korth, bowling in his first tournament as a super senior, won his $7^{\text {th }}$ title. He defeated tournament leader, Rob Downer, in a very exciting match. The two were tied after regulation at 256 . In a $9^{\text {th }}$ and $10^{\text {th }}$ frame roll off, Rob went $1^{\text {st }}$, had a 9 , spare. Then it was Tom's turn, he struck in the ninth and then struck on his $1^{\text {st }}$ ball in the $10^{\text {th }}$, then got an 8 count for the win.

Tom was the only player to have 8 200s in match play. Interestingly, Tom had a chance to win on his last his last shot in regulation. He needed at least 9 on his last shot, but got 8 to tie.

Rob is looking for his $3^{\text {rd }}$ title of the season and the $5^{\text {th }}$ over all title. He was the high qualifier with 1911. He secured the \#1 position with his last 2 games of 275 and 279 . Rob is currently in $2^{\text {nd }}$ in the points race.

In $3^{\text {rd }}$ place was rookie Dave Bordson. With his $2^{\text {nd }}$ top 5 finish of the season. He beat Gene Captain 279 to 205, then lost to Korth, 258 to 235 . He was $3^{\text {rd }}$ high qualifier.

Fourth place belonged to Gene Captain. This is Gene's high finish to date. His previous high was a $5^{\text {th }}$. He qualified in fifth, met and defeated Roger Blad and Mike Wirz in the $1^{\text {st }}$ ladder game.
Another rookie, Craig Schiffler, in his 2 ${ }^{\text {nd }}$ MSC, placed fifth. In a close match, Captain edged Schiffler. This was Schiffler's $1^{\text {st }}$ cashing finish (his $2^{\text {nd }} M S C$ ).
Mike Wirz finished in $6^{\text {th }}$ place. He was prevented from advancing by Captain, who shot a 240 against his 236 . With this finish, Mike increased his leading points total to 106 . He also added to his total prize money won. His total is currently high. He is looking for his $2^{\text {nd }}$ title of the season.

Roger Blad was the seeded SDS player in the $1^{\text {st }}$ ladder game. He needed to win the game to advance. He drops to his qualifying position, which was $9^{\text {th }}$. Roger is looking for his $7^{\text {th }}$ title.

The "stink hole" belonged to Ken Holets.

etc- To all who played the Southtown tournament: A sincere apology for what transpired.

There would have been no problems had I declared the 4 non functional lanes "non existent"instead of substituting lanes for them.
In retrospect, it could be argued that the second game should not have been negated. However, to proceed from that point would have been fraught with confusion.

To review what happened; Lanes 17 \& 18 were out of play and I substituted $24 \& 25$ in their stead. Halfway through the $1^{\text {st }}$ game, after a 15 to 20 minute wait, lanes 5 \& 6 became non usable. The players were moved to $27 \& 28$, which I substituted for $5 \& 6$. By the time they finished, most of the field had moved to their next lanes and some were already in the $5^{\text {th }}$ frame.

So, here we had 22 lanes going in the $2^{\text {nd }}$ game and the 4 players who just finished on 27 \& 28 had no place to go because their next pairs were being erroneously used by other players. What happened?
Some players counted the "out of use" lanes in their moving pattern.
Since we are a match play venue, proceeding from this point would have been chaotic.

Right or wrong, a decision had to be made and the suggestion to negate the $2^{\text {nd }}$ game was presented to the players and they agreed with the decision. The decision to restart at the $3^{\text {rd }}$ game level in the moving pattern was a good one.

The last 6 qualifying games proceeded smoothly.

In the future, MSC entry fees will only be refunded at the discretion of the Director. Also, taking warm ups without paying the entry fee will be allowed only with the Director's permission.
