# MIDWEST SENIOR CLASSIC 

## January 10, 2015 Season 21, Issue 8

> The MSC is a bowling venue for fifty and older players (male or female) to compete in against each other.
> You must be at least 50 on the day of the tournament.

We have 12 events per year, June through May. Entry fee is $\$ 90$ for members, $\$ 100$ for non- members, membership is $\$ 45$ per season.

Payout is 1 for 2 , same day. The format is 8 random match games, with the $8^{\text {th }}$ game being a position round. A 4 or 5 game step ladder follows

When there are 8 or more SS or, if there are 6 or more SDS, one must be in the ladder; and if there are 4 or more ROGs, one must be in the ladder.

There must be at least one player under 59 and at least one player over 59 in the ladder, no matter anything else.

Age Classifications
50 through 58 is a regular 59 through 64 is a super senior(ss) 65 through 69 is a super duper(sds)
70 and older is a real old guy(rog)
To cash, you must finish in the top $50 \%$ Of your age bracket. Payout is guaranteed

The year end tournament has added money to each payout position. To qualify for the year end event, you must be a member and have played at least 3 tournaments in the 2014-15 season.

Your age determines your classification. You do not have the option of moving into another age bracket. For more info, go to

> Another match between the 2 leaders for PoY was won by Brian Floen, as he defeated Rob Downer for the 2nd consecutive tournament. As he did last month against Downer, he shot a 279 in the title match. This was his 9 th title. With the win, he moves closer to the lead on the PoY list, behind Downer.

> This was the 3 rd consecutive month these 2 players met for the title, with Downer winning once. These 2 players put on a great show. Downer has been in the title match for 4 consecutive months, losing 3 of them. But, his opponents have been shooting 270 's against him. For the record, this was the $6^{\text {th }}$ time these 2 have met in a title game, with Floen winning 4. Stay tuned, more such matches are sure to follow.

> To get to the title match, Floen defeated Tim Racette in a match decided by an errant Racette shot. After a string of strikes, Racette left a greek church, from which he could not recover. Tim is looking to win his $4^{\text {th }}$ title. He also has 9 other top 5 finishes.

> Fourth place went to the oldest player in the field, Mike Schmid. Mike was seeded into the ladder and proceeded to defeat Carl Fietek and Tom Havlish in the 1st ladder game. Unfortunately, he had to bowl Floen in the next game. Mike has 3 titles on his resume along with 17 other top 5 finishes.

> Tom Havlish finished in $5^{\text {th }}$, continuing his excellent bowling since recovering from his left knee replacement. Tom had the $4^{\text {th }}$ highest scratch total to qualify for the ladder. He is looking for his $2^{\text {nd }}$ win of the season and $7^{\text {th }}$ over all.

> Carl Fietek qualified $5^{\text {th }}$ to get to the ladder. This is his rookie season and is looking for his first title, which he will eventually win. Like Havlish, he was a couple of strikes shy of winning the $1^{\text {st }}$ ladder game.

## New For the 2014-2015 season

1. The number of required tournaments for the year end tournament has been reduced from 4 to 3 .

2: Only the top 5 qualifiers will make the stepladder along with the necessary seeds.

3: High games out of the money will be eliminated. Instead the money will be awarded to players bumped from the natural prize list. The award will be $\$ 40$ credits toward an entry
into a future tournament.
4: Players bumped from the prize list will be awarded player of the year points.
5: A 75 and older age bracket will be created. This bracket will pay 1 for 2 . For ladder seeding purposes, this bracket will fall into the 70 to 74 bracket.
