# MIDWEST SENIOR CLASSIC 

## Season 24, Issue 8

## About us:

The MSC is a bowling venue for fifty and older players, female or male. Please note that all participants must be at LEAST 50 years of age on the day of the tournament to compete.

## Dues \& Fees:

The MSC offers 12 Events per year, June through May. Entry Fees for each tournament are $\$ 90$ for Members and $\$ 100$ for NonMembers. The MSC Membership is $\$ 45$ per participant each season. Non-member fees are not applicable to the membership fee. Cash is the preferred method of entry fees.

For first time entrants, checks will be accepted.

## How it Works:

Payout is 1 for 2 , same day. The format is 7 random match games, with an $8^{\text {th }}$ game being a position round. The top 5 plus any seeds go into the stepladder. A 4 or 5 game Stepladder follows. When there are 4 or more Super Seniors or if there are 4 or More Real Old Guys, one must be in the ladder. There must be at least one bowler over 59 years of age in the ladder.

To cash, one must finish in the top $50 \%$ of one's age bracket, otherwise you DO NOT cash. Cashing will be based on 1 for 2 for each age bracket. Only exceptions: all players over 59 who finish in the natural prize list will cash.
Woman are guaranteed a 1 for 2 pay out
The year-end tournament has added money to each payout position. To qualify for the year end event, a bowler must be a member and have played at least 4 tournaments in the 2017-2018 season.
Any questions regarding payout and scoring will be left to the discretion of the Director.

## Age Classifications:

50 through 59 is a "Regular" 60 through 67 is a "Super Senior" (SS) 68 and Older is a "Real Old Guy" (ROG). One's age determines the bracket they are in.

Every tournament is certified by the USBC.

Rob Downer won all 9 of his matches to win his $2^{\text {nd }}$ title of the season and $14^{\text {th }}$ overall. Downer was the qualifying leader and met Ken Holets in the title game. Holets had just shot 781 in the 3 previous ladder games to get to the title game.
Downer began the game with 5 strikes to assume a big lead. After 2 single pin spares, Downer struck out for a 267 . Holets did not get consecutive strikes until the $6^{\text {th }}$ frame, which was too little too late, as Downer wins big. This $14^{\text {th }}$ title ties him with Al Loth for $2^{\text {nd }}$ in the number of career titles. The leader in this category, Clark Poelzer, has 16 . This was his $47^{\text {th }}$ top 5 finish, also $2^{\text {nd }}$ to Poelzer's 61.

Holets began the tournament with a $1^{\text {st }}$ game 299, leaving a 9 pin. He qualified $4^{\text {th }}$. He is looking to win his $3^{\text {rd }}$ title. As noted above, he had a 269 , 244, and 268 to win 3 ladder matches against formidable opponents. Holets admitted after the match that 12 games was one too many for him. Nevertheless, a fine performance and a good tournament result.

Third place was taken by Mike Wirz, looking for title \#9. Wirz was high actual to go with 6 wins, which qualified second. He shot a 258 , usually enough to win a match, but not quite enough to defeat a red hot Holets. Wirz last won a title in April of last year. He is threat to win in every event. He was 1 of 4 players to shoot 8200 s in qualifying.

Craig Goodwin, a recent newcomer to the MSC, finished in $4^{\text {th }}$. He is looking for title \#2, having won in his $1^{\text {st }}$ MSC. A $2898^{\text {th }}$ game made him $3^{\text {rd }}$ qualifier. In his match against Holets, 2 big splits cost him. 4 strikes in his last 5 shots lessened the margin of defeat against Holet's 244 . Based on the results of the 3 MSCs he has played, look for him to be in the ladder again.

Fifth place went to the RoG, Terry Schacht. Schacht has 5 titles to his credit. As the seed, he was pitted against Larry Birkedahl, the $5^{\text {th }}$ place qualifier. This was a high scoring match, with Schacht running 7 strikes to eke out a 258 to 245 win. Both players could have had more, but some single pins didn't cooperate. A fun match to watch. Schacht then met the aforementioned Holets. Birkedahl has a $1^{\text {st }}$ and 22 nds to his credit, as he is always a threat to win.
