The MSC is a bowling venue for fifty and older players (male or female) to compete in against each other.

You must be at least 50 on the day of the tournament.

We have 12 events per year, June through May. Entry fee is \$90 for members, \$100 for non-members, membership is \$45 per season.

Payout is 1 for 2, same day.

The format is 8 random match games, with the 8th game being a position round. A 4,5 or 6 game step ladder follows

When there are 8 or more SS or, if there are 6 or more SDS, one must be in the ladder; and if there are 4 or more ROGs, one must be in the ladder.

There must be at least one player under 59 and at least one player over 59 in the ladder, no matter anything else.

Age Classifications
50 through 58 is a regular
59 through 64 is a super senior(ss)
65 through 69 is a super duper(sds)
70 and older is a real old guy(rog)

To cash, you must finish in the top 50% Of your age bracket. Payout is guaranteed

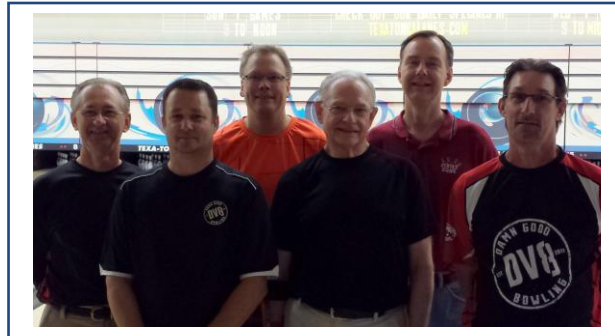
The year end tournament has added money to each payout position. To qualify for the year end event, you must be a member and have played at least 3 tournaments in the 2014-15 season.

Your age determines your classification. You do not have the option of moving into another age bracket. For more info, go to

Playing his 2nd MSC as an old guy, Sam Lantto won his first MSC. Sam averaged 250 to be the leading qualifier. For his last 4 games of qualifying, he averaged 260. In the title game, he bettered that by shooting a 279 against John Hommes. A well deserved victory.

Hommes started qualifying with a 300 game, his 33rd. John qualified 3rd, averaging 230. To get to the title game, he defeated 2 opponents in the ladder. John is looking to win his 2nd MSC title. John finished 5th in the past season's POY. Expect this youngster to have another banner year.

Finishing third was Clark Poelzer. He is looking to win his 17 title. Unfortunately for him, he was a strike short in advancing to the title match. Nevertheless, he had a good day, as he averaged 245. Last year was an average year for him and we expect him to continue to have another similar year.

As an aside, with 1 week remaining in the USBC championships, Poelzer and his son are still in the lead in the doubles. Also, should he win an Eagle, he may be the oldest to accomplish the feat.

4th place went to Tom Swanson, his highest finish to date. Tom, as the high ROG, was seeded into the ladder and he won 2 matches. He needed one more strike to beat Hommes in the 3rd ladder game.

Looking for his 1st title is Dave Rasmus, who finished in 5th. To get to the top 5, Dave needed a big game and he shot a 290. That put into 4th place. Dave was only 1 of 3 players to knock down 1900 pins.

Finishing in 6th was Craig Schiffler. In the 1st ladder game, he struggled to get lined up and when he did, it was too late. Craig was the runner up in the POY last season. Look for him to have another good season.

New For the 2014-2015 season

1: The number of required tournaments for the year end tournament has been reduced from 4 to 3.

2: Only the top 5 qualifiers will make the stepladder along with the necessary seeds.

3: High games out of the money will be eliminated. Instead the money will be awarded to players bumped from the natural prize list. The award will be \$40 credits toward an entry into a future tournament.

4: Players bumped from the prize list will be awarded player of the year points.

5: A 75 and older age bracket will be created. This bracket will pay 1 for 2. For ladder seeding purposes, this bracket will fall into the 70 to 74 bracket.
