

MIDWEST SENIOR CLASSIC

The MSC is a bowling venue for fifty and older players (male or female) to compete in against each other.
You must be at least 50 on the day of the tournament.

We have 12 events per year, June through May. Entry fee is \$90 for members, \$100 for non- members, membership is \$45 per season.

Payout is 1 for 2, same day.
The format is 8 random match games, with the 8th game being a position round. A 4, 5 or 6 game step ladder follows

When there are 8 or more SS or, if there are 6 or more SDS, one must be in the ladder; and if there are 4 or more ROGs, one must be in the ladder.

There must be at least one player under 59 and at least one player over 59 in the ladder, no matter anything else.

Age Classifications
50 through 58 is a regular
59 through 64 is a super senior(ss)
65 through 69 is a super duper(sds)
70 and older is a real old guy(rog)

To cash, you must finish in the top 50%
Of your age bracket. Payout is guaranteed

The year end tournament has added money to each payout position. To qualify for the year end event, you must be a member and have played at least 3 tournaments in the 2014-15 season.

Your age determines your classification. You do not have the option of moving into another age bracket. For more info, go to midwestseniorclassic.com/

Any questions related to payout and scoring will be left to the discretion of the Director.

Craig Schiffler finished the season in fine fashion by defeating the tournament leader and POY, Rob Downer, for his 2nd title of the year and 3rd of his career. Schiffler started the event with an 807. Schiffler was 2nd high qualifier. He beat John Hommes 278 to 263 to advance to the title game.

Schiffler started the title game with a triple and kept Downer at bay. Downer played well but his carry was not very good. Nevertheless, Downer had another great year as he again became PoY. He has won the PoY award for the 3rd consecutive year. During this season, he won 1 tournament and had 6 other top 5 finishes. He becomes the 3rd player to win 3 consecutive PoY awards.

John Hommes had a very good year as he won 1 tournament and finished in the top 5 4 other times. He qualified in 3rd. He met and defeated Ken Schrapp in the 3rd ladder game to advance against Schiffler. He shot 263 in the game but it was not enough.

In 4th was Ken Schrapp, who is looking for his first title. Ken was 1 of 4 players to knock down over 1900 pins in qualifying. Schrapp beat Don Theis in the 2nd ladder game to advance. Ken has several top 5 finishes to his credit.

5th place was won by Don Theis. He defeated 2 players in the 1st ladder game to advance. He shot a 278 to move on. He missed 2 10 pins in the next game to lose to Schrapp's 225. This was his 2nd 5th of the year.

Randy Bartz qualified 5th and Neil Busch qualified 6th to qualify for the 1st ladder game. Bartz has 2 titles and several top 5 finishes to his credit. Neil has never won a title, but he does have 4 2nds and 4 3rds to his credit.

New For the 2014-2015 season

1: The number of required tournaments for the year end tournament has been reduced from 4 to 3.

2: Only the top 5 qualifiers will make the stepladder along with the necessary seeds.

3: High games out of the money will be eliminated. Instead the money will be awarded to players bumped from the natural prize list. The award will be \$40 credits toward an entry into a future tournament.

4: Players bumped from the prize list will be awarded player of the year points

5: A 75 and older age bracket will be created. This bracket will pay 1 for 2. For ladder seeding purposes, this bracket will fall into the 70 to 74 bracket.
