The MSC is a bowling venue for fifty and older players (male or female) to compete in against each other.

You must be at least 50 on the day of the tournament.

We have 12 events per year, June through May. Entry fee is \$90 for members, \$100 for non-members, membership is \$45 per season.

Payout is 1 for 2, same day.
The format is 8 random match games, with the 8th game being a position round. A 4, 5 or 6 game step ladder follows

When there are 8 or more SS or, if there are 6 or more SDS, one must be in the ladder; and if there are 4 or more ROGs, one must be in the ladder.

There must be at least one player under 59 and at least one player over 59 in the ladder, no matter anything else.

Age Classifications
50 through 58 is a regular
59 through 64 is a super senior(ss)
65 through 69 is a super duper(sds)
70 and older is a real old guy(rog)

To cash, you must finish in the top 50% Of your age bracket. Payout is guaranteed

The year end tournament has added money to each payout position. To qualify for the year end event, you must be a member and have played at least 4 tournaments in the 2013-14 season.

For every 20 bowlers, there will be a non casher high game

Your age determines your classification. You do not have the option of moving into another age bracket. For more info, go to midwestseniorclassic.com/

Any questions related to payout and scoring will be left to the discretion of the Director.

It has been 2 ½ years since Clark Poelzer last won an MSC. Today he did it the hard way as he qualified in 6th and had to fight his way through 6 players to win. The title match against top seeded Craig Schiffler was decided in the 10th frame. There were 12 games out of 312 greater than 250 and Poelzer had 3 of them, a 299, 300, and 255. This title adds to raises his MSC record total of 16.

Schiffler was the only player to average 220 in qualifying. He was looking to win his 2nd title of the season. A disastrous split in the 10th earned him a 2nd and 23 PoY pts. He and Poelzer are virtually tied for 2nd in the points race.

8 time titlist Tom Korth finished 3rd. Korth was the victim of Poelzer's 255 game. Tom was second high scratch qualifier.

Fourth went to Neil Busch. Busch had the misfortune of playing Poelzer twice, once in qualifying and again in the ladder. Poelzer averaged 299.5 against him. Busch has 4 seconds to his credit and 7 other top 5 finishes.

Having his best event of the year was Dave Olynyk, as he finished in fifth. Like all the other players, he was a stepping stone for Poelzer. Dave has several top 5 finishes to his credit.

Sixth place was taken by Rob Downer. This finish clinched the POY honor for the season. This continues his streak of POY to 3. Rob has 8 career titles.

In the "stink hole", for the 2nd time this season, was Ken Hanson.
