## MIDWEST SENIOR CLASSIC

The MSC is a bowling venue for fifty and older players (male or female).
One must be at least 50 on the day of thetournament.

We have 9 events per year, September through May.Entry fee is $\$ 90$ for members, $\$ 100$ for nonmembers, membership is $\$ 45$ per season.

Payout is 1 for 2 , same day.
The format is 7 random match games, with an $8^{\text {th }}$ game being a position round. A 4 or 5 game step ladder follows

Step ladder formula, top five, if no SS, SDS, or ROG is among the top 5 qualifiers, then the following formula is used:

If there are 6 or more SS , the high SS is seeded, If there are 4 or more SDS, the high SDS is seeded; If there are 4 or more RoG, the high RoG is seeded
Seeds play each other in the 1 st ladder game. There must be at least one player under 59
For more specific stepladder rules go to our website and see rules

Age Classifications
50 through 58 is a regular
59 through 64 is a super senior(ss)
65 through 69 is a super duper(sds)
70 and older is a real old guy(rog)

To cash, generally, you must finish in the top 50\% of your age bracket. There are rare exceptions to this statement.

The yearend tournament has added money to each payout position. To qualify for the year end event, one must be amember and have played at least 3 tournaments in the 2016-17 season.

One's age determines your classification. One doesnot have the option of moving into another age bracket.

1 to Champion Clark Poelzer, Brian Floen, John Hommes, Ron Nelson, Mike Wirz, Carl Hendrickson
Clark Poelzer won his $17^{\text {th }}$ title by defeating Brian Floen. Poelzer showed why he has so many titles to his credit when he made a ball change in the $6^{\text {th }}$ frame. In the $1^{\text {st }} 5$ frames he had 4 weak 10 pin leaves and a strike. With the new ball, he had the last 6.

Poelzer qualified in second, making a big move in the position round with a 279 win . To get to the final, he beat Mike Wirz in a match that was determined in the last frame.
Brian Floen is looking for title number 11. Floen was the high scratch qualifier, averaging 10 more pins a game than the $2^{\text {nd }}$ high qualifier. 4 of the games were 250 or better. This $2^{\text {nd }}$ place finish was the $8^{\text {th }}$ such MSC finish.

Mike Wirz's third place finish was his $9^{\text {th. }}$ To get to the quarter final game, he beat Ron Nelson. Last year's PoY is looking to win his $8^{\text {th }}$ title.

Ron Nelson finished in fourth place. He defeated John Hommes in the second ladder game to win the right to advance against Wirz. Nelson had the $6^{\text {th }}$ high scratch.total. During qualifying, this smooth stroking righty shot the $9^{\text {th }} 300$ of his career. Nelson is an infrequent MSC player.

Fifth place went to John Hommes. Hommes played Carl Hendrickson in the first ladder game. Hommes had 11 strikes for a 279 to win. Against Nelson was able to strike only 3 times, which left him a few pins short of advancing.Hommes is looking for title number 2.

Playing in the first ladder game against Hommes was Carl Hendrickson, Carl bowled well, but it's difficult to beat a 279 game.
