The MSC is a bowling venue for fifty and older players (male or female) to compete in against each other.
You must be at least 50 on the day of the tournament.

We have 12 events per year, June through May. Entry fee is $\$ 90$ for members, $\$ 100$ for non- members, membership is $\$ 45$ per season.

Payout is 1 for 2 , same day.
The format is 8 random match games, with the $8^{\text {th }}$ game being a position round. A 4 or 5 game step ladder follows

When there are 8 or more SS or, if there are 6 or more SDS, one must be in the ladder; and if there are 4 or more ROGs, one must be in the ladder.

There must be at least one player under 59 and at least one player over 59 in the ladder, no matter anything else.

## Age Classifications

50 through 58 is a regular 59 through 64 is a super senior(ss) 65 through 69 is a super duper(sds)
70 and older is a real old guy $(\mathrm{rog})$

To cash, you must finish in the top 50\% Of your age bracket. Payout is guaranteed

The year end tournament has added money to each payout position. To qualify for the year end event, you must be a member and have played at least 3 tournaments in the 2014-15 season.

Your age determines your classification. You do not have the option of moving into another age bracket. For more info, go to

This was a close match through 9 frames, but as it goes, it's what one has at the end that counts. This was Floen's 10th title and third of the year. He qualified in third. He beat Mike Schmid, then beat Dave Hasley to advance into the title game. With 2 events remaining, he has a very good chance of unseating the reigning PoY, Rob Downer.
Steve Janssen had a very poor tournament beginning, as he shot 155 and 168 in the first 2 games. Then he averaged 260 for the final 6 qualifying games. Steve is looking for his 3rd title. A split in the 1st frame caused him to trail from the start.
He was able to double, but strikes were hard to come by. Nevertheless, a good event!
Finishing in third was Dave Hasley, a first time MSC player. He was the scratch leader and qualified second. In the semi final game, he had a chance to win. In the 10th frame, Floen opened and left the door open. Hasley needed a strike to
win, but the shot was a little high. Hasley bowled very well.
Fourth place finisher was our favorite ROG, Mike Schmid. Mike qualified in fifth and was 4th high scratch. He defeated Dave Whitman in the first match. The game was close until the 9th when Schmid struck and then struck out in the 10th. Mike is looking for title \#4. Mike was the only player with 8 deuce games. He has 18 top 5 finishes to his credit. As an aside, Mike was the first player to win consecutive MSC tournaments. This achievement occurred in September and October of 1996. In the game against Floen, he just did not get enough strikes.
In fifth place was Dave Whitman, his first stepladder appearance. Whitman qualified in fourth. This was only his second MSC. As previously mentioned, the game against Schmid was close. Dave had a pretty good tournament.

The "stink hole" went to Clark Poelzer, with 15 titles, the MSC leader in this category. He had an opportunity to gain the ladder but shot a 169 in the position round.
