# MIDWEST SENIOR CLASSIC 

## Season 22, Issue 1

The MSC is a bowling venue for fifty and older players (male or female) to compete in against each other.
You must be at least 50 on the day of the tournament.

We have 12 events per year, June through May. Entry fee is $\$ 90$ for members, $\$ 100$ for non- members, membership is $\$ 45$ per season.

Payout is 1 for 2 , same day.
The format is 8 random match games, with the $8^{\text {th }}$ game being a position round. A 4 or 5 game step ladder follows

When there are 8 or more SS or, if there are 6 or more SDS, one must be in the ladder; and if there are 4 or more ROGs, one must be in the ladder.

There must be at least one player under 59 and at least one player over 59 in the ladder, no matter anything else.

## Age Classifications

 50 through 58 is a regular 59 through 64 is a super senior(ss) 65 through 69 is a super duper(sds) 70 and older is a real old guy(rog)To cash, you must finish in the top $50 \%$ Of your age bracket. Payout is guaranteed

The year end tournament has added money to each payout position. To qualify for the year end event, you must be a member and have played at least 3 tournaments in the 2014-15 season.

Your age determines your classification. You do not have the option of moving into another age bracket. For more info, go to

Treasure Island was the site of the Jim Lindquist Memorial Tournament. Bob Micek was an excellent host, providing a good shot, great pizza and some wonderful door prizes.

44 players showed, in spite of a beautiful day. The field averaged 212 and produced a 300 game.

The title game was close until the $9^{\text {th }}$ frame. Dave Lutz out bowled Rob Downer, the "PoY" for the past 3 seasons. Lutz won his $2^{\text {nd }}$ title of the season and $4^{\text {th }}$ of his career. In qualifying, Lutz was the only player to exceed 1900 and produce a300 game. During a 3 game stretch, he had 279, 279, and a 300. It took him 1 game to get lined up, as he had a 198 Start

Downer is looking for his 11 title. This finish was his $12^{\text {th }}$ second in MSC events. Rob qualified in $2^{\text {nd }}$. He finished $2^{\text {nd }}$ in the PoY race, $2^{\text {nd }}$ in the money list, $1^{\text {st }}$ in average and $1^{\text {st }}$ in games won. Just an average year for him.

John Hommes finished in $3^{\text {rd }}$. John is looking to add another title to the one he has. He qualified in $3^{\text {rd, }}$ defeated Fietek, 228 to 224, to meet Downer in the semi final. This was the highest scoring match of the ladder, as Downer edged Hommes, 259 to 259. From a spectator's view point, a fun match. This was his $5^{\text {th }}$ career third place finish.

Carl Fietek took $4^{\text {th }}$ place, his high finish to date. He qualified in $4^{\text {th }}$, defeating Hal Abrams in the second ladder game to advance. He lost to Hommes in a close match by 4 pins. He had a chance to win the game in the $10^{\text {th }}$ against Hommes, but an errant shot left him short. Look for this player to have a great sophomore year in the 2015-2016 season.

This tournament was unusual in that 3 players were seeded into the ladder. Hal Abrams, Tom Havlish and Gary Ring played each other for the right to advance. All 3 players had a chance to win, as their scores were virtually even going into the $10^{\text {th }}$. Abrams was the victor by 1 pin over Havlish to advance in the ladder.. Abrams and Ring were looking for their $1^{\text {st }}$ title, while Havlish is looking for title seven.
