# MIDWEST SENIOR CLASSIC 

Season 24, Issue 1

The MSC is a bowling venue for fifty and older players (male or female).
One must be at least 50 on the day of the tournament.

We have 12 events per year, June through May. Entry fee is $\$ 90$ for members, $\$ 100$ for non- members, membership is $\$ 45$ per season.

Payout is 1 for 2 , same day.
The format is 7 random match games, with an $8^{\text {th }}$ game being a position round. A 4 or 5 game step ladder follows

When there are 6 or more SS or if there are 4 or more ROGs, one must be in the ladder.

There must be at least one player under 59 and at least one player over 59 in the ladder, no matter anything else.

Age Classifications
50 through 59 is a regular
60 through 67 is a super senior(ss)
68 and older is a real old guy(rog)
To cash, you must finish in the top $50 \%$ Of one's age bracket, otherwise you Do not cash.

The year end tournament has added money to each payout position. To qualify for the year end event, one must be a member and have played at least 4
tournaments in the 2017-18 season.

One's age determines your classification. One does not have the option of moving into another age bracket. For more info, go to

Ron Cleveland defeated leading qualifier Larry Birkedahl to win his $2^{\text {nd }}$ title of the season and $5^{\text {th }}$ overall. Cleveland won all 10 the matches he played.

He needed to defeat a red hot player, Clark Poelzer, to advance to the title game. Cleveland was $2^{\text {nd }}$ high qualifier and had 8 deuce games. This win earned him a spot on the All STAR Team.

Birkedahl, the leading qualifier, began the match with a split and then after a three bagger, suffered a fatal blow with a pocket 7-10(is there another way to leave this).Birkedahl bowled very well, averaging 252 and winning 7 matches. Larry was seeking his $2^{\text {nd }}$ title, having won earlier in the season.

Birkedahl is the MSC Rookie of the year. He won a tournament and finished $6^{\text {th }}$ in the PoY points.

Finishing in $3^{\text {rd }}$ for the $11^{\text {th }}$ time in MSC competition was Clark Poelzer. Poelzer qualified fifth and then proceded to advance by defeating Mike Schmid, Rob Downer and Craig Schiffler before losing to Cleveland.

Another good event for this SDS player. He is looking to win title number 18. He averaged 235 and won 6 matches for the event. He has 60 top 5 finishes to his credit.

Fourth place went to Craig Schiffler. He qualified $3{ }^{\text {rd }}$ and lost to Poelzer in the $10^{\text {th }}$ frame of the quarterfinal game.. He averaged 241 for this event. He is looking to win his $6^{\text {th }}$ title. With this finish, he earned a spot on the ALL STAR Team.

Finishing in $5^{\text {th }}$ for $6^{\text {th }}$ time in MSC competition, was Rob Downer. This finish earned him the MSC's Player of the Year. This is his $4^{\text {th }} \mathrm{PoY}$ award. He trails Poelzer 5 PoY awards, the current MSC record. Downer qualified $4^{\text {th }}$ and lost to Poelzer in the $2^{\text {nd }}$ ladder game. Just another good tournament.

Missing the stepladder by 24 pins was Warren Manske, who has bowled very well this and last month's events. Last month, he shot a300 and in this event had a 299. A good way to end the season!!!!!!
