## MIDWEST SENIOR CLASSIC

The MSC is a bowling venue for fifty and older players (male or female) to compete in against each other.
You must be at least 50 on the day of the tournament.

We have 12 events per year, June through May. Entry fee is $\$ 90$ for members, \$100 for non- members, membership is $\$ 45$ per season.

Payout is 1 for 2 , same day.
The format is 8 random match games, with the $8^{\text {th }}$ game being a position round.

A 4 or 5 game step ladder follows

When there are 8 or more SS or, if there are 6 or more SDS, one must be in the ladder; and if there are 4 or more ROGs, one must be in the ladder.

There must be at least one player under 59 and at least one player over 59 in the ladder, no matter anything else.

## Age Classifications

50 through 58 is a regular 59 through 64 is a super senior(ss) 65 through 69 is a super duper(sds) 70 and older is a real old guy(rog)

To cash, you must finish in the top $50 \%$ Of your age bracket. Payout is guaranteed

The year end tournament has added money to each payout position. To qualify for the year end event, you must be a member and have played at least 3 tournaments in the 2014-15 season.

Your age determines your classification. You do not have the option of moving into another age bracket. For more info, go to

Any questions related to payout and scoring will be left to the discretion of the Director.

Each MSC tournament is certified by the Carl Hendrickson won his second title. In winning,

Carl Hendrickson had a very good day as he won his 2nd title. To use a billiards term, he ran the table after being seeded into the ladder. He becomes the first "ROG" to win an MSC. He is the 2nd oldest to win (Bob Hanson was 73 when he won 13 years ago). Carl qualified 9th and was seeded into the ladder. He won the 1st game by one pin and kept on winning. Carl had everything going his way as he took advantage of the breaks given him.
Carl is only the 7th player older than 65 to win an MSC in 204 events since 1994.

As he moved through the ladder, he played better. The title match against John Hommes was very close as it was decided in 9th and 10th. Also, He becomes the first seed to run a 7 player ladder. In sum, he had a very good tournament.

Hommes was seeking his second title. He was 2 pins shy of averaging 250 in qualifying. 5 of his games were 250 or better. He liked the shot!! A few errant shots in the title game were costly. With this second, Hommes moved into PoY contention. This was his 3rd second place finish.

Third place was taken by Karl Kampa, also seeking his second title. Karl qualified second, one of 4 players with 1900+ scratch pins. Against Hendrickson, he was a strike shy of winning.

Brian Floen was 4th, his 6th such finish. He was seeking his 10th title. With this finish he assumes the lead in the PoY point standings. He was the victim of a Hendrickson 255 game.

Larry Thompson finished in 5th. Larry had a great tournament as he qualified fourth. He was edged by Hendrickson. As usually is the case, one strike in the right place would have won him the game. Larry is an infrequent MSC player, but In the few events he has bowled, he has done well.

The other 2 players in the ladder were Clark Poelzer and Dave Bordson. Clark is looking for title \#17 and Dave is looking for his first title. Clark had a chance to win in the 10 th but 210 pins resulted in a no win.
