# MIDWEST SENIDR CLASSIC 

The MSC is a bowling venue for fifty and older players (male or female).
One must be at least 50 on the day of thetournament.

We have 9 events per year, September through May.Entry fee is $\$ 90$ for members, $\$ 100$ for nonmembers, membership is $\$ 45$ per season.

Payout is 1 for 2 , same day.
The format is 7 random match games, with an $8^{\text {th }}$ game being a position round. A 4 or 5 game step ladder follows

Step ladder formula, top five, if no SS, SDS, or ROG is among the top 5 qualifiers, then the following formula is used:
If there are 6 or more SS, the high SS is seeded, If there are 4 or more SDS, the high SDS is seeded; If there are 4 or more RoG, the high RoG is seeded
Seeds play each other in the $1^{\text {st }}$ ladder game. There must be at least one player under 59
For more specific stepladder rules go to our website and see rules

Age Classifications
50 through 58 is a regular
59 through 64 is a super senior(ss)
65 through 69 is a super duper(sds)
70 and older is a real old guy(rog)
To cash, generally, you must finish in the top $50 \%$ of your age bracket. There are rare exceptions to this statement.

The yearend tournament has added money to each payout position. To qualify for the year end event, one must be amember and have played at least 3 tournaments in the 2016-17 season.

One's age determines your classification. One doesnot have the option of moving into another age bracket.

## Just another tournament decided in the $10^{\text {th }}$ frame

Larry Birkedahl outlasted Dave Olynyk to win his $1^{\text {st }}$ MSC title, by a score of 213 to 209. Birkedahl appeared to have everything going his way after a 5 bagger from 3 through 7 . Birkedahl missed a 10 pin in the $8^{\text {th }}$ to give Olynyk an opportunity to reduce his deficit. Olynyk responded with a 3 bagger entering the $10^{\text {th }}$ with a chance to shut out Birkedahl. Olynyk's $1^{\text {st }}$ shot in the $10^{\text {th }}$ was not good as it left the big 4 . As a result, Birkedahl needed only a good count on his $1^{\text {st }}$ shot in the $10^{\mathrm{th}}$. Birkedahl accomplished a rare feat this season by winning all 8 qualifying matches. No other player won more than 6 matches. Birkedahl's previous high a $2^{\text {nd }}$ earlier this season. For Olynyk, this finish exceeded his previous high finishes.

Third place went to Sam Lantto, who was defeated by Olynyk in the semifinal game. Sam made good shots but his carry was not good. Lantto had one double in the game while Olynyk had 8 strikes in 9 frames to win going away. Lantto was high scratch qualifier. Lantto is looking for his $3^{\text {rd }}$ MSC title.

Fourth place finisher was Keith Orth, his MSC high to date. Orth won the opening game in a close match against Hendrickson. In the second match against Olynyk, he was in the game until his body failed him. Nevertheless, he had a great event.

Carl Hendrickson finished in the top 5 for the second consecutive event. Carl was handicapped by 2 big splits, which he was unable to convert. Hendrickson was leading the event through 5 games. He is looking for title number 3 to go with his other 18 top 5 finishes.

Other players having a good event were Craig Schiffler, missing the ladder by 10 pins; Steve Mewhorter, his high finish to date, missing the ladder by 25 pins.
