The MSC is a bowling venue for fifty and older players (male or female) to compete in against each other.
You must be at least 50 on the day of the tournament.

We have 12 events per year, June through May. Entry fee is $\$ 90$ for members $\$ 100$ for non- members, membership is $\$ 45$ per season.

Payout is 1 for 2 , same day.
The format is 8 random match games, with the 8 game being a position round. A 4 or 5 game stap ladder follows

When there are 8 or more SS or, if there are 6 or more SDS, one must be in the ladder; and if there are 4 or more ROGs, one must be in the ladder.

There must be at least one player over 59 in the ladder, no matter anything else.

Age Classifications
50 through 58 is a regular
59 through 64 is a super senior(ss)
65 through 69 is a super duper(sds)
70 and older is a real old guy(rog)
To cash, you must finish in the top 50\%
Of your age bracket. Payout is guaranteed
1 for 2 for ss, sds and rogs.
The year end tournament has added money to each payout position. To qualify for the year end event, you must be a member and have played at least 4 tournaments
in the 2012-13 season.
For every 20 bowlers, there will be a
non casher high game

Your age determines your classification. You do not have the option of moving into another age bracket.

Any questions related to payout and scoring will be left to the discretion of the Director.

#### Abstract

Doug Burnikel qualified for his first stepladder. He was $5^{\text {th }}$ and met Terry Halida in the $1^{\text {st }}$ ladder game. The game seemed over after Doug finished his $10^{\text {th }}$ frame. Halida needed a mark in the $10^{\text {th }}$. Terry bowled and left a split. This resulted in a tie. Going $1^{\text {st }}$ in a $9 \& 10^{\text {th }}$ rolloff, Terry spared. Doug pitched a three bagger to win. Terry is looking for his $4^{\text {th }}$ title. This was the high finish for each of these players for the season.
