The MSC is a bowling venue for fifty and older players (male or female) to compete in against each other.
You must be at least 50 on the day of the tournament.

We have 12 events per year, June through May. Entry fee is $\$ 90$ for members $\$ 100$ for non- members, membership is $\$ 45$ per season.

Payout is 1 for 2 , same day.
The format is 8 random match games, with the 8 game being a position round. A 4 or 5 game stap ladder follows

When there are 8 or more SS or, if there are 6 or more SDS, one must be in the ladder; and if there are 4 or more ROGs, one must be in the ladder.

There must be at least one player over 59 in the ladder, no matter anything else.

Age Classifications
50 through 58 is a regular 59 through 64 is a super senior(ss) 65 through 69 is a super duper(sds) 70 and older is a real old guy(rog)

To cash, you must finish in the top 50\% Of your age bracket. Payout is guaranteed 1 for 2 for ss, sds and rogs.

The year end tournament has added money to each payout position. To qualify for the year end event, you must be a member and have played at least 4 tournaments in the 2013-14 season.

For every 20 bowlers, there will be a

Your age determines your classification. You do not have the option of moving into another age bracket. For more info, go to midwestseniorclassic.com/

Gary Green led the tournament from the
beginning to the very end! He began with a 258 and never stopped scoring. He defeated Craig Schiffler in a close match, going down to the $10^{\text {th }}$ frame. The match was decided by a ringing 10 pin, one by each player. Both players threw 7 strikes but Green's placement edged Schiffler 235 to 233. Green won his $4^{\text {th }}$ title and Schiffler is looking for his second title.

In the first ladder game, sixth place qualifier, Clark Poelzer (SS) took on Ed Mahagnoul (ROG) and George Blazej (SDS). Clark threw a solid game 215 to Mahagnoul's 184 and Blazej's no hitter 155 to advance to face John Hommes who finished qualifying in fifth place.

This second game was a close one even though Hommes had one early open to Poelzer's clean game. To late solid 4 pins in the $6^{\text {th }}$ and $7^{\text {th }}$ frame and a solid 10 pin in the $10^{\text {th }}$ frame left Clark to finish $6^{\text {th }}$ in a close match 218 for Poetzer and Hommes a 229 to advance to face Dave Lutz.

In the third step ladder game, John Hommes started out with a turkey and never looked back finishing with a 257 to Dave Lutz 195.

Moving on to the fourth step ladder game John Hommes stepped up to face Craig Schiffler. Schiffler started with a turkey and he finished with a 236 to Hommes 179.

Craig Schiffer's next opponent was the second high qualifier, Rob Downer. Downer coming off a fantastic year as the 2012 MSC Player of the Year and second consecutive title! In a very close match Schiffler edged Downer 194 to 186 to face Green.
