The MSC is a bowling venue for fifty and older players (male or female) to compete in against each other. You must be at least 50 on the day of the tournament.

We have 12 events per year, June through May. Entry fee is \$90 for members, \$100 for non- members, membership is \$45 per season.

Payout is 1 for 2, same day. The format is 8 random match games, with the 8th game being a position round. A 4 or 5 game step ladder follows

When there are 8 or more SS or, if there are 6 or more SDS, one must be in the ladder; and if there are 4 or more ROGs, one must be in the ladder.

There must be at least one player over 59 in the ladder, no matter anything else.

Age Classifications 50 through 58 is a regular 59 through 64 is a super senior(ss) 65 through 69 is a super duper(sds) 70 and older is a real old guy(rog)

To cash, you must finish in the top 50% Of your age bracket. Payout is guaranteed 1 for 2 for ss, sds and rogs.

The year end tournament has added money to each payout position. To qualify for the year end event, you must be a member and have played at least 4 tournaments in the 2012-13 season.

For every 20 bowlers, there will be a

Your age determines your classification. You do not have the option of moving into another age bracket.

Any questions related to payout and scoring will be left to the discretion of the Director.

For the second time in the MSC, a title was decided in over time. <u>A great match to watch.</u> Rob Downer defeated Dave Lutz in a roll off to win his 2nd title of the season and 6th over all.

These 2 players are battling for the POY. Each has won twice this season. They are currently 1-2 in POY race. They are 1-2 in the prize list and 1-2 in average. Lutz finished 1st and forced Downer to strike out in the 10^{th,} just to tie. Three more perfect strikes have never been thrown.

Lutz was the qualifying leader. He started slow and finished strong, having 8 deuce games.. Downer had 7 deuces and finished strong.

To get to the title game, Downer defeated Tom Havlish 257 to 224. Downer was impressive in this match. Tom is looking for title #6. Instead he finished with his 3rd career 3rd place finish. Tom had 8 deuces.

Roger Blad qualified 10th but because of his advanced age, was seeded into the ladder. He took advantage by winning 2 matches. He couldn't miss against Poelzer and then bowled well against Freeman, edging him 244 to 236. Roger is looking for title # 7. He finished with his career 10th 4th place finish. He is the leader in the Senior POY.

Dave Freeman had another good tournament as he finished in 5th place. He is looking for his second title. Dave is in 3rd in the POY race, looking to move up in the remaining 3 events.

And looking for his 16th career title was Clark Poelzer. Clark, multiple time POY, is a contender for the points race in both age brackets.
