The MSC is a bowling venue for fifty and older players (male or female) to compete in against each other.
You must be at least 50 on the day of the tournament.

We have 12 events per year, June through May. Entry fee is $\$ 90$ for members, $\$ 100$ for non- members, membership is $\$ 45$ per season.

Payout is 1 for 2 , same day.
The format is 8 random mathch games, with the 8 game being a position round. A 4 or 5 game step ladder follows

When there are 8 or more SS or, if there are 6 or more SDS, one must be in the ladder; and if there are 4 or more ROGs, one must be in the ladder.

There must be at least one player over 59 in the ladder, no matter anything else.

Age Classifications
50 through 58 is a regular 59 through 64 is a super senior(ss) 65 through 69 is a super duper(sds) 70 and older is a real old guy(rog)

To cash, you must finish in the top 50\% Of your age bracket. Payout is guaranteed 1 for 2 for ss, sds and rogs.

The year end tournament has added money to each payout position. To qualify for the year end event, you must be a member and have played at least 4 tournaments
in the 2013-14 season.
For every 20 bowlers, there will be a
non casher high game

Your age determines your classification. You do not have the option of moving into another age bracket. For more info, go to midwestseniorclassic.com/

Karl Kampa won his first title by defeating Jay Joyner. Karl was on his game, as he led all with a 1953 scratch total and winning all 8 match games in qualifying. In the title match, Karl had a 3 bagger and finished with a 4 bagger. A great tournament for him!!!!!

Joyner is looking to add another title to his resume. He was second high scratch and won 6 games. He defeated Jeff Baker in the semi final game to advance to the final. Joyner's $2^{\text {nd }}$ and $3^{\text {rd }}$ frames in the final were his undoing, nevertheless, a fine tournament.

Jeff Baker is looking for title \#2. He was the $3^{\text {rd }}$ high qualifier and met Tm Racette in the ladder and defeated him in a close match. Baker's $8^{\text {th }}$ and $9^{\text {th }}$ frames against Joyner led to his loss. Baker's first 3 qualifying games totaled 782.

Racette finished the tournament with his $10^{\text {th }}$ top 5 finish. He defeated Ed Peterson and Don Theis for the right to meet Baker. Tim is looking for title \#4. In the match against Baker, his 2 opens in the $7^{\text {th }}$ and $8^{\text {th }}$ led to his defeat.

Theis finished in $5^{\text {th }}$. He qualified in $4^{\text {th }}$ and was only one of 3 players to qualify with at least 1900 pins. This finish equaled his high finish.

Ed Peterson was the $6^{\text {th }}$ ladder player. He is looking for his first title. Ed had a 299 during qualifying. Against Racette, he had 6 single pin leaves with only 3 strikes.

The "stink hole" went to Gary Green.
