The MSC is a bowling venue for fifty and older players (male or female).

One must be at least 50 on the day of the tournament.

We have 12 events per year, June through May. Entry fee is \$90 for members, \$100 for non-members, membership is \$45 per season.

Payout is 1 for 2, same day.
The format is 7 random match
games, with an 8th game being a
position round. A 4 or 5 game step
ladder follows

When there are 6 or more SS or, if there are 4 or more SDS, one must be in the ladder; and if there are 4 or more ROGs, one must be in the ladder.

There must be at least one player under 59 and at least one player over 59 in the ladder, no matter anything else.

Age Classifications
50 through 58 is a regular
59 through 64 is a super senior(ss)
65 through 69 is a super duper(sds)
70 and older is a real old guy(rog)

To cash, generally, you must finish in the top 50% of your age bracket. There are rare exceptions to this statement.

The year end tournament has added money to each payout position. To qualify for the year end event, one must be a member and have played at least 3 tournaments in the 2015-16 season.

One's age determines your classification. One does not have the option of moving into another age bracket. For more info, go to

Ron Cleveland accomplished a rare feat, winning consecutive tournaments. As he did last month, he began with the highest ladder start and highest 3 game start. The only difference, he was not the qualifying leader. He did knock down the most pins. He met Karl Kampa in the semi final and defeated him in a close match to advance against Clark Poelzer. This title and its points puts him in second place in the PoY standings, behind Mike Wirz.

The title match was close, as Cleveland edged Poelzer. Both players began with 4 strikes. In the 5th, Ron struck and Clark left a 9 pin, spared, then had a double. They played even the final frames. For Clark, he is looking for title #16. He had to settle for his 12th second.

Third went to Kampa, who is looking for title #2. He qualified in 3rd and defeated Tim Racette in a close match to advance against Cleveland. Against Cleveland, he lost another close game. Nevertheless, he had a very good tournament.

Tim Racette was looking to win title #4, but lost by 5 pins to Kampa. He did beat George Blazej to advance. Racette qualified in 4th. This was his 13th top 5 finish.

George Blazej qualified 5th and finished in 5th. He was unable to match strikes with Racette and was defeated. He has no titles but does have 6 top 5 finishes. He defeated Rich Latvala in the first ladder game to advance.

Rich Latvala was seeded, could not get lined up and lost. He has 2 seconds and 8 other top 5 finishes to his credit.
