The MSC is a bowling venue for fifty and older players (male or female) to compete in against each other.
You must be at least 50 on the day of the tournament.
We have 12 events per year, June through May.
Entry fee is $\$ 90$ for members, $\$ 100$ for nonmembers, membership is $\$ 45$ per season.

Payout is 1 for 2 , same day.
Format is 8 match gms, with the $8^{\text {th }}$ game being a position round. This is followed by a stepladder.
When there are 6 or more SDS, one must be in the ladder; and if there are 4 or more ROGs, one must be in the ladder. And if there are 8 or more SS, 1 must be in the ladder. There must be at least one player over 59 in the ladder, no matter anything else.

Age Classifications 50 through 58 is a regular
59 through 64 is a super senior(ss)
65 through 69 is a super duper(sds)
70 and older is a real old guy(rog)
Payout is guaranteed 1 for 2 for ss , sds and rogs.
The year end tournament has added money to each payout position.
To qualify for the year end event, you must be a member and have played at least 4 tournaments in the 2012-13 season.
For every 20 bowlers, there will be a non casher high game

Your age determines your classification. You do not have the option of moving into another age bracket.

Any questions related to payout and scoring will be left to the discretion of the Director.
Each MSC tournament is certified by the USBC

Rob Downer defeated Brian Floen in a match that was decided in the $10^{\text {th }}$ frame. Rob finished first, had the last 5 strikes to finished with 239 . Brian had a 4 bagger going into the $10^{\text {th }}$, needed to strike in the $10^{\text {th }}$ frame. He left a slam 7 pin to finish in second.

Rob won his $5^{\text {th }}$ title and kept his streak of never having failed to cash in an MSC event alive. The defending POY qualified in second place. He defeated Craig Schiffler in the semi final game to advance. With the victory, Rob put himself into $6^{\text {th }}$ place in the season points race .

Floen was looking for his $7^{\text {th }}$ title. In the title match, he left five 7 pins. Brian was the tournament leader with 1915 pins and 280 bonus points. Brian is the season leader in the points race.

Craig Schiffler finished third, his highest to date. Downer beat him in the semi final after he defeated Dale Seath in the quarter final game. Craig knocked down second highest number of pins. With this finish, Craig move into $4^{\text {th }}$ place in the points race.

Finishing in fourth and looking for his second title, was Dale Seath. Dale qualified in $5^{\text {th }}$. He shot a 287 in the $1^{\text {st }}$ ladder game to advance. He met Tom Corbett and defeated him in a close game. He then lost to Schiffler. With this finish, he moves into $10^{\text {th }}$ place in the points race.

Tom Corbett took $5^{\text {th }}$ place. Tom lost to Seath because of a stubborn back row pin. Tom is having a very good year. He is currently in second in the points race. Tom is still looking for his $1^{\text {st }}$ title. He has several seconds, so he is due to win.
Tom Korth finished in $6^{\text {th }}$ place. He is looking for his $9^{\text {th }}$ title.. Watch out for this guy.
Also in the ladder was Tom Gallivan, he is looking for his $2^{\text {nd }}$ title. He has 7 seconds in MSC competition.
Gary Green finished in the "stink hole".
