# MIDWEST SENIOR CLASSIC 

## Season 23, Issue 1

The MSC is a bowling venue for fifty and older players (male or female).
One must be at least 50 on the day of the tournament.

We have 9 events per year, September through May. Entry fee is $\$ 90$ for members, $\$ 100$ for non- members, membership is $\$ 45$ per season.

Payout is 1 for 2 , same day.
The format is 7 random match games, with an $8^{\text {th }}$ game being a position round. A 4 or 5 game step ladder follows

Step ladder formula, top five, if no SS, SDS, or ROG is among the top 5 , then one from each group must be seeded.
Seeds play each other in the $1^{\text {st }}$ ladder game. There must be at least one player under 59 For more specific stepladder rules go to our website

Age Classifications 50 through 58 is a regular 59 through 64 is a super senior(ss) 65 through 69 is a super duper(sds) 70 and older is a real old guy(rog)

To cash, generally, you must finish in the top $50 \%$ of your age bracket. There are rare exceptions to this statement.

The year end tournament has added money to each payout position. To qualify for the year end event, one must be a member and have played at least 3 tournaments in the 2016-17 season.

One's age determines your classification. One does not have the option of moving into another age bracket.

Craig Schiffler won the season opener by defeating Dave Oulman. Schiffler won his $5^{\text {th }}$ MSC title as a result. The title game was close for 9 frames and was decided in the $10^{\text {th }}$ when Schiffler struck out. Schiffler averaged an impressive 250 in qulalifying.

Oulman bowled well, averaging 241 in qualifying third. He defeated 2 tough players to reach the title game. He shot a 268 and a 244 to advance. Last years' rookie of the year has yet to win a title, but again he was second. He shot a 299 the $2^{\text {nd }}$ game. Look for him to win his first title this season.

Third place went to 11 time titlist, Rob Downer. He qualified second. This was Downer's first MSC since incurring an injury this past winter. He seems to have recovered nicely. Look for him to win a title or 2 this season. Welcome Back!

Fourth place went to Dana Wright. Wright qualified in $5^{\text {th }}$. He won 2 ladder games with games of 202 and 259. He then lost to Oulman's 268. Another nice tourney for him. He has yet to win a title, but this will be the year he does it.

Sam Lantto finished in $5^{\text {th }}$. Lantto is looking for his third title, which he will surely get if he plays more MSC events. He qualified $4^{\text {th }}$, averaging 240. Lantto had the misfortune of going against a 259 game in his ladder game.

The first ladder game had 3 seeded players, Ken Holets, Jay Joyner and George Blazej.

Holets emerged the winner with a very nice 276 game, followed by Joyner with a 248, and Blazej with a 213. Holets has 2 titles in his MSC resume, including 23 top 5 finishes. Only 4 players have had more $2^{\text {nd }}$ place finishes than Holets.

Joyner has a title among his 21 top 5 finishes He was only 1 of 3 players to have 8200 games in qualifying.

George Blazej shot a game worth more than the 213 he finished with. He has 7 top 5 finishes to his credit.
