# MIDWEST SENIOR CLASSIC

> The MSC is a bowling venue for fifty and older players (male or female) to compete in against each other.
> You must be at least 50 on the day of the tournament.

We have 12 events per year, June through May. Entry fee is $\$ 90$ for members, $\$ 100$ for non- members, membership is $\$ 45$ per season.

Payout is 1 for 2 , same day. The format is 8 random match games, with the $8^{\text {th }}$ game being a position round. A 4,5 or 6 game step ladder follows

When there are 8 or more SS or, if there are 6 or more SDS, one must be in the ladder; and if there are 4 or more ROGs, one must be in the ladder.

There must be at least one player under 59 and at least one player over 59 in the ladder, no matter anything else.

Age Classifications
50 through 58 is a regular 59 through 64 is a super senior(ss) 65 through 69 is a super duper(sds) 70 and older is a real old guy(rog)

To cash, you must finish in the top $50 \%$ Of your age bracket. Payout is guaranteed

The year end tournament has added money to each payout position. To qualify for the year end event, you must be a member and have played at least 3 tournaments in the 2014-15 season.

Your age determines your classification. You do not have the option of moving into another age bracket. For more info, go to

Brian Floen won his $8^{\text {th }}$ title by defeating Rob Downer, 278 to 228 . Floen began qualifying with a 279,300 and 249,3 game total of 828 . His final 3 games (including the ladder) were 268, 279 and 279 . For the 10 games, he averaged 257. With this win, he moves into the points race. This title Tom Korth's total of 8 , which is the $5^{\text {th }}$ highest total. Above him are Downer with 9, Jim Lindquist with 12, AI Loth with 12 and Clark Poelzer with 16.

Downer was the leading qualifier a scratch total of 2038, an average of 255 . With this $2^{\text {nd }}$, he, also, moves into the race for "PoY"., a title that he has held for the past 3 seasons. He is now tied with John Hommes for the points lead. Downer now has 10 2nds in addition to 9 titles.

Hommes finished in $3^{\text {rd }}$, with another fine performance. His problem?, finding a way to beat Floen's 279 in the semi final. He qualified 3 rd with 1927. John is looking for title \#2. He has 10 top 5 finishes to his credit. He.defeated Dale Seath in the quarterfinal with a 255.

Seath (SS) was seeded into the ladder along with Don Theis (ROG). He defeated Theis and Tim Racette with a 279 game. Seath was the high SS qualifier, with a 3 pin margin over Ken Holets. After dispatching Theis and Racette, he bowled Ron Cleveland, whom he defeated 268 to 248 .. Seath then lost to Hommes'255. Seath is looking for his $2^{\text {nd }}$ title. He does have 11 top 5 finishes.

Ron Cleveland finished in $5^{\text {th }}$, his high finish to date. Cleveland's 248 was good but not enough to advance past Seath. Cleveland was the $4^{\text {th }}$ high qualifier. He began qualifying with 785.

Sixth place went to Tim Racette. He does have 11 top five finishes in addition to 3 titles. In the first ladder game against Seath and Theis, he couldn't carry, as he shot a 199.

The $3^{\text {rd }}$ player in the first ladder game was Theis, who started the game with 8 strikes, only to fall to Seath's 279.

New For the 2014-2015 season

1. The number of required tournaments for the year end tournament has been reduced from 4 to 3 .

2: Only the top 5 qualifiers will make the stepladder along with the necessary seeds.

3: High games out of the money will be eliminated. Instead the money will be awarded to players bumped from the natural prize list. The award will be $\$ 40$ credits toward an entry
into a future tournament.
4: Players bumped from the prize list will be awarded player of the year points.
5: A 75 and older age bracket will be created. This bracket will pay 1 for 2 . For ladder seeding purposes, this bracket will fall into the 70 to 74 bracket.
