# MIDWEST SENIOR CLASSIC 

About us:
The MSC is a bowling venue for fifty and older players, female or male. Please note that all participants must be at LEAST 50 years of age on the day of the tournament to compete.

## Dues \& Fees:

The MSC offers 12 Events per year, June through May. Entry Fees for each tournament are $\$ 90$ for Members and $\$ 100$ for NonMembers. The MSC Membership is $\$ 45$ per participant each season. Non-member fees are not applicable to the membership fee. Cash is the preferred method of entry fees.

For first time entrants, checks will be accepted.

## How it Works:

Payout is 1 for 2 , same day. The format is 7 random match games, with an $8^{\text {th }}$ game being a position round. The top 5 plus any seeds go into the stepladder. A 4 or 5 game Stepladder follows. When there are 4 or more Super Seniors or if there are 4 or More Real Old Guys, one must be in the ladder. There must be at least one bowler over 59 years of age in the ladder.

To cash, one must finish in the top $50 \%$ of one's age bracket, otherwise you DO NOT cash. Cashing will be based on 1 for 2 for each age bracket. Only exceptions: all players over 59 who finish in the natural prize list will cash.
Women are guaranteed a 1 for 2 pay out
The year-end tournament has added money to each payout position. To qualify for the year end event, a bowler must be a member and have played at least 4 tournaments in the 2018-2019 season.
Any questions regarding payout and scoring will be left to the discretion of the Director.

## Age Classifications:

50 through 59 is a "Regular"
60 through 67 is a "Super Senior" (SS) 68 and Older is a "Real Old Guy" (ROG). One's age determines the bracket they are in.

Every tournament is certified by the USBC.

Clark Poelzer defeated John Hommes in the title game to win his first title of the season and $19^{\text {th }}$ MSC title. The win breaks a tie for career titles with Rob Downer, who has 18 to his credit. Poelzer began the title game with 5 strikes and stayed clean to finish with 233 to Hommes' 215. Poelzer was high scratch qualifier, averaging 211 and winning 6 matches.

Hommes was second high qualifier, also with 6 matches won.
This was Hommes' $5^{\text {th }}$ second place finish. He does have 1 title to his credit. His run of bad luck in title matches did not change with this tournament. The biggest break of the match was an errant shot by the usually accurate Poelzer that resulted in a strike in the middle of a strike string. Hommes was unable to overcome it. With their finishes, both players move into the PoY top 10 point list.

Third place went to Last years RoY, Tom Jones. Jones struck out against Dana Wright to advance against Hommes. A poor $9^{\text {th }}$ frame shot against Hommes cost him the match. Jones' finish keeps him in $4^{\text {th }}$ place in the PoY standings. Jones has 4 top 5 finishes and is looking for title number 1.

Wright's $4^{\text {th }}$ place finish was his $3^{\text {rd }}$ top 5 finish through 5 events to date. His consistent bowling to date has him in second place in the PoY list. He has 1 title and several seconds to his credit. A second title will be added soon if he continues his excellent bowling.

Ron Cleveland finished fifth. A split in the $10^{\text {th }}$ frame against Wright was his undoing, as he lost by the score of 198 to 185. Going into the $10^{\text {th }}$, he was on a turkey. Wright had no doubles in this game, but was clean. Cleveland is looking to add another title to the five he has.
