You must be at least 50 on the day of the tournament.

We have 12 events per year, June through May. Entry fee is \$90 for members, \$100 for non- members, membership is \$45 per season.

Payout is 1 for 2, same day.
The format is 8 random match
games, with the 8 game being a
position round. A 4,5 or 6 game
step ladder follows

When there are 8 or more SS or, if there are 6 or more SDS, one must be in the ladder; and if there are 4 or more ROGs, one must be in the ladder.

There must be at least one player under 59 and at least one player over 59 in the ladder, no matter anything else.

Age Classifications
50 through 58 is a regular
59 through 64 is a super senior(ss)
65 through 69 is a super duper(sds)
70 and older is a real old guy(rog)

To cash, you must finish in the top 50% Of your age bracket. Payout is guaranteed

The year end tournament has added money to each payout position. To qualify for the year end event, you must be a member and have played at least 3 tournaments in the 2014-15 season.

Your age determines your classification. You do not have the option of moving into another age bracket. For more info, go to midwestseniorclassic.com/

Tom played a consistent game to defeat Floen, who, uncharacteristically, struggled. The win was Havlish's 6th career title. Since his last win in 2007, he has had knee surgery. I'm told his game is looking like that of 7 years ago. Last month he finished 6th and seems to be headed for a good year.

Floen knocked down the most pins with a 1945 total. He qualified in 3rd. He defeated Schmid and Hommes to earn a shot in the title match. He just could not get lined up in the game. He is looking for title #8.

Third went to John Hommes. After 3 events, John has a 2nd, a 6th and a 3rd.Needless to say, his year has an excellent beginning. He is the current leader in the POY race. John has 2 titles to his credit. He lost to Floen in the semi final.

Mike Schmid, the ageless one, finished in 4th. He has 3 titles to his credit. Mike was seeded, but defeated Schiffler in the 1st ladder game. Then he met Bordson and shot a 238 to win again. He was a strike shy in the 3rd ladder game against Floen. Nevertheless, he had a great tournament.

Dave Bordson finished in 5th. Dave has several top 5 finishes to his credit. He has yet to win a title, but he is a contender for a title in each event he enters. Dave started the day with a 300 game.

Sixth place went to Craig Schiffler, a 3 time titlist. Craig started the day poorly, then averaged 253 the last 6 games. In the 1st ladder game, he was unable to get lined up until the 8th frame, when he punched out.

Sitting in the "stink hole " was Terry Schacht, a 5 time titlist.

- 11The number of required tournaments for the year end tournament has been reduced from 4 to 3.
- 2: Only the top 5 qualifiers will make the stepladder along with the necessary seeds.
- 3: High games out of the money will be eliminated. Instead the money will be awarded to players bumped from the natural prize list. The award will be \$40 credits toward an entry into a future tournament.
- 4: Players bumped from the prize list will be awarded player of the year points.
- 5: A 75 and older age bracket will be created. This bracket will pay 1 for 2. For ladder seeding purposes, this bracket will fall into the 70 to 74 bracket.
