The MSC is a bowling venue for fifty and older players (male or female) to compete in against each other. You must be at least 50 on the day of the tournament.

We have 12 events per year, June through May.

Entry fee is \$90 for members, \$100 for non-members, membership is \$45 per season.

Payout is 1 for 2, same day.

Format is 8 match gms, with the 8th game being a position round. This is followed by a stepladder.

If any age bracket has 8 or more, then that group is guaranteed a spot in the ladder. If no group has 8 or more, then at least 1 player over 59 must be in the ladder.

To Cash, You must beat 50% of the players in your age Classification

Age Classifications

50 through 58 is a regular

59 through 64 is a super senior(ss)

65 through 69 is a super duper(sds)

70 and older is a real old guy(rog)

Payout is guaranteed 1 for 2 for ss, sds and rogs.

The year end tournament has added money to each payout position.

To qualify for the year end event, you must be a member and have played at least 4 tournaments in the 2010-2011 season.

For every 13 bowlers, there will be a non casher high game

Any questions related to payout and scoring will be left to the discretion of the Director.

Each MSC tournament is certified by the USBC

Nano!! Nano!! was the cry heard after Wirz defeated Halida to win his 4th MSC title. Wirz used a Storm Virtual Gravity Nano ball to power his way through 3 step ladder opponents on his path to the win.

He was awesome. According to some in the audience, a straight player, like Mike, should not be allowed to use such a ball 'cause he will be unbeatable.

Wirz was 3rd high scratch and 3rd qualifier. Wirz accomplished a rare feat by defending the title he won here last year. To get to the final, he had to beat 2 players who were also bowling good, Schmid and Downer.

Terry Halida, the leading qualifier, was looking to win his 3rd title. For 7 frames, he was even with Wirz, then came a couple of back row leaves which spelled the end for him. Halida shot 804 his last 3 games to move into 1st.

Also looking for his 3rd title was Rob Downer. He was the 2nd high qualifier and played a great game against Wirz, but that old bugaboo, "10 pins" prevented him from moving on. He did finish with a 235, but it was a little short. Rob has never failed to cash in a MSC tournament.

Finishing in 4th was the oldest player in the ladder, SDS Mike Schmid. Mike qualified in 5th and defeated John Stuebner in the first ladder game. This game was the lowest scoring stepladder match in MSC history, with a 149 beating a 136. Moving to a different pair made a difference as Schmid beat Roger Thompson, 231 to 206. Then he got run over by Wirz, 279 to 213.

Schmid has 3 titles to his credit. He was the 1st player to win consecutive tournaments.

Fifth place went to another player looking for his 4th title, Roger Thompson. Roger had another great tournament. He qualified 4th and had the misfortune of having to meet a hot bowler, Schmid. Roger's last title was at Earle Brown in February of 2010.

Bowling in his 4th MSC and doing it well was John Stuebner. John qualified in 6th place. He and Schmid participated in a game, which neither player could mark. This is John's second appearance in a MSC stepladder. In his first MSC, he also made the ladder. He had a good tournament. Look for this guy to show up in a ladder again.

And sitting in the "STINK HOLE" was John Hommes. This was his 1st MSC. He missed the ladder by 9 pins. With any **real luck**, he would have been the 6th qualifier. How so, you ask? In the 6th game, Havlish needed 4 pins to on his fill shot to beat Hommes, he got 3 for the tie. The story goes that he was lucky it wasn't a gutter.

Greg Schroeder, playing in his 2nd MSC, was the qualifying leader.

After 3 tournaments, only 2 players have won 8 games in a tournament. Further, only 5 players have won 7 games in a tournament.

The first 3 tournaments of the young season have produced no honor scores. That's 815 games, the highest score being 289.

The field average for the 815 games is 213.

First time occurrence: The player with the highest total of scratch pins did not qualify for the stepladder. Tom Havlish was the unlucky player. His total of 1853 was high, but his opponents shot 1892 against him. But, he did manage to win 3 games.

After 3 tournaments, the ratio of prize money won by each age group is as follows:

Regular Seniors constitute 59.9% of the entries and

have won 59.7% of the prize money.

Super Seniors are 16% of entries and have won

24.4% of the prize money.

Super Duper Seniors constitute 18.1% of the field

and have won 12.25% of the prize fund.

Lastly, the Real Old Guys are 6% of the field and

have won 3.6% of the prize fund.

Note:

more than 2 titles won by 59+ players.

Several seasons had no titles won by SS, SDS or ROG players.

Eight titles were won by players 59 and older! AMAZING!

5 titles for Super Seniors, 3 titles won by Super Duper Players.

Also; There was 1 first time winner, 8 with a previous title, 3 players won 2 titles during the season, and 3 titles won by a left handed player.

2. **The field average for all players for all 12 tournaments was 212.3.**

3. The prize fund for the season was \$33,720.

17.6 % was won by SS, they were 17.2 % of the entries

16.9 % was won by SDS, they were 16.6 % of the entries

4.2 % was won by ROG, they were 6.1 % of the entries

61.3 % was won by the regular seniors, they were 60.0 % of the entries.

Please note, the number of entries and subsequent purses varied monthly.

4. There were 457 total entries by 90 different players.

6 players participated in all 12 tournaments, 6 played 11, 7 played 10, 3 played 9

5 played 8, 5 played 7 and 27 players entered a tournament.

5. Of the 90 players, 55 were members.
